Your patient can become uncomfortable while you're out of the room. Give them a way to let you know. These are wireless and have several sounds to choose from. Pick a different bell for each treatment room and be sure to test them regularly.

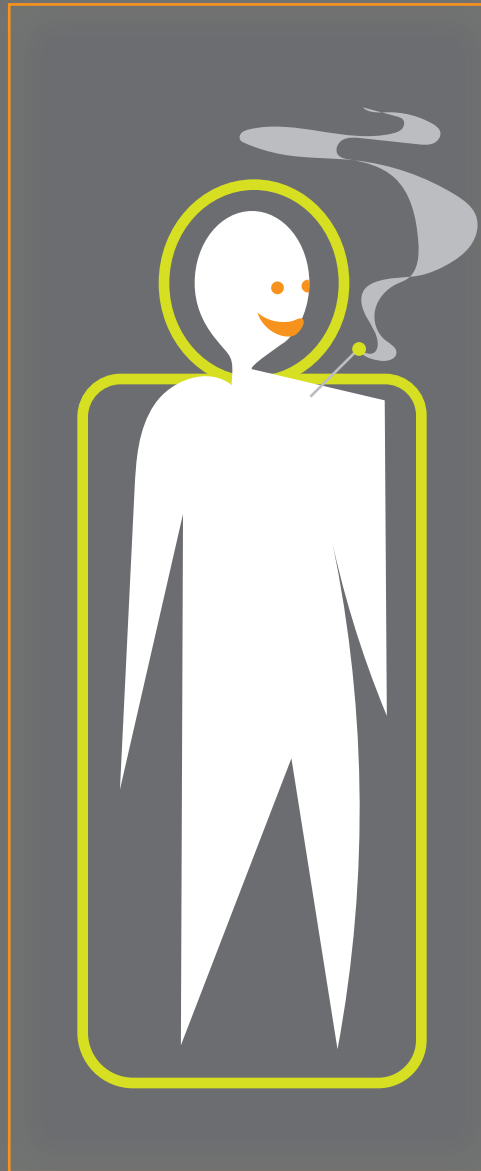
## Drapes

30"x 50" fabric drapes. Cover the table, cover the bolsters, and use to strategically drape your patient's privates. Much nicer and more comfortable than paper. Use your favorite color. Everyone's happy!

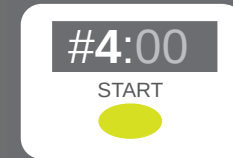


## COUGH DROPS

Always have these little guys at the ready. When a patient gets a dryspot in their throat, and a coughing fit ensues while you're lighting mugwort, you'll be glad you did.

## TIMER

Pick these up for about a dollar. A great investment. One for each treatment room. Make sure to label them with a room #.
